



1. Open the EPA How's My Waterway tool. Enter an address, zip code, or place for your project area in the search bar near the top.



2. Once your project area has been located on the map, refer to the information on the right side of the screen.
3. Select the **Overview** tab at the top. Under this tab, you will find information regarding **Waterbody Conditions**. Waterbodies in your project area will be listed, along with their condition status.
