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Section 106 Resources

- The Pony Express, California Trail, Oregon Trail, and Mormon Pioneer Trail cross the DPA
- There is one National Register of Historic Places resource within the DPA
 - o Dawson County Courthouse
- 3 Tribes have interest in Dawson, Gosper, and Phelps Counties
 - o Apache Tribe of Oklahoma
 - o Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes, Oklahoma
 - o Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma

Biological Resources

- Federally Listed Species Range
 - o Monarch Butterfly – Proposed Threatened
 - o Piping Plover – Threatened
 - o Regal Fritillary – Proposed Threatened
 - o Rufa Red Knot – Threatened
 - o Whooping Crane – Endangered
- State Listed Species Range
 - o Interior Least Tern – Endangered
 - o Northern Long-eared Bat – Endangered
 - o Piping Plover – Threatened
 - o Whooping Crane – Endangered
- Critical Habitat is present
 - o Whooping Crane

Floodplain

- The DPA includes multiple flood hazard zones
 - o Zone A (100-year / 1% annual chance) floodplain
 - o Zone AE (100-year / 1% annual chance) floodplain
 - o Zone AE (Regulatory Floodway)
 - o Zone X (500-year / 0.2% annual chance) floodplain
